

The Weston's Community Pool Rules

1. **Swim at your own risk.** No lifeguard on duty. All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and are solely responsible for their safety.
2. **Pool is for use of Westons Residents and their guests ONLY.**
3. A maximum of 4 guests per family at any one time is allowed in the pool.
The Westons resident must be present at the pool with their guests.
Please be considerate of other residents when inviting guests.
4. The **Wading Pool is for small children only.** Children must be less than 48 in. tall to play in the wading pool. An **adult must supervise** children in the wading pool. The gate to the wading pool must remain closed.
5. **Adults must supervise the children they bring to the pool.** An adult (eighteen years of age or older) must accompany children under the age of fourteen and those who can not swim regardless of age. Indiana State Law is written this way: "No swimming alone. **Children under 14 years of age and non-swimmers shall not use the pool unless accompanied by a responsible adult.**"
6. **No dangerous play: No diving. No running,** rough play, spitting, dunking or profanity. Parents are expected to supervise their children.
7. No smoking. No alcoholic beverages. No glass containers or other breakable objects are allowed in the restrooms or pool area.
No drinks or food allowed in the pool.
8. No animals of any kind are allowed in the pool or the pool area.
9. Only swimsuits may be worn into the water. Showers must be taken before entering the water. Persons having infectious diseases, open sores, bandages, cuts or recent vaccinations must not enter the water.
10. **Children in diapers must wear swim diapers under their swimsuit.** Do not change diapers poolside.
11. Contact Pool Vendor and Ardsley Management if a fecal or vomit accident occurs. Pool will be closed for 12 – 24 hours in accordance with State law.
12. Swimming is prohibited within 30 minutes of thunder or lightening.
Residents need to clear the pool and leave the pool house until severe weather has passed.
13. Pool hours of Operation are clearly posted at the pool. The pool must be cleared and residents and guest must leave the pool house at the time of closing.
14. Residents and Guests must follow Weston Pool Rules. The Weston Place HOA reserves the right to revoke any pool access card at any time if Weston Pool Rules or State Health Code ordinances are violated.
